

Nearly 400 years ago the history of the Passion Play began. In 1633 the Oberammergau villagers promised to perform the suffering, death and resurrection of Christ every tenth year, in so far as no one was to die of the plague anymore. The villagers' plight was answered by God and therefore in 1634 the first Passion Play took place. The promise has been kept until today! All actors of the world's largest amateur dramatic performance come from the village, since a special play law is in effect. All participants, from actors to members of the choir, orchestra members, firemen and ushers, must have been born in Oberammergau or have lived there for at least 20 years. Altogether, more than 2,000 Oberammergau villagers will participate in the 2022 Passion Play.

Tour Program

Day 1 Thursday, 5 May - Departure from OR Tambo Int Airport

We say goodbye to our loved ones as we leave Johannesburg to start our journey of a lifetime. We will depart from OR Tambo International Airport (19:40) for Venice Marco Polo Airport. Dinner and breakfast on board.

*Please be at the airport 3 hours prior to departure.

Day 2 Friday, 6 May - Venice

Upon arrival in Venice at midday we will be greeted by our representative that will escort us to the bus for transfer to our hotel. The evening is free to leisure Venice at our own accord. The hotel well situated with a 5min walk from the nearest train station. *Overnight in Venice.

Venice is built on more than 100 small islands in a lagoon in the Adriatic Sea. It has no roads, just canals - including the Grand Canal thoroughfare - lined with Renaissance and Gothic palaces. The central square, Piazza San Marco, contains St. Mark's Basilica, which is tiled with Byzantine mosaics, and the Campanile bell tower offering views of the city's red roofs.



Day 3 Saturday, 7 May - Embarkment of the MSC Sinfonia

Following breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for embarkment on board the **MSC Sinfonia***. The luxuries MSC Sinfonia has many entertainment, sport and festivity options available for all passengers that can be enjoyed freely. We will also have the opportunity to experience a wide variety of cuisines at the different restaurants that is available throughout the whole voyage. With so many attractions offered on the vessel, there will be ample time to make lifetime and almost countless memories of this amazing cruise.

The ship will depart Venice at 16:00. *Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner included.



Day 4 Sunday, 8 May - Kotor, Montenegro

Breakfast & lunch onboard the cruise. The vessel will dock in Kotor, Montenegro at 14:00. Passengers are able to explore this beautiful town on their own or they can make a booking for the excursions offered by MSC. Kotor is a fortified town on Montenegro's Adriatic coast, in a bay near the limestone cliffs of Mt. Lovćen. Characterized by winding streets and squares, its medieval old town has several Romanesque churches, including Kotor Cathedral. It's also home to the Maritime Museum, which explores local seafaring history. Sveti Đorđe, one of 2 tiny islands off the ancient town of Perast, features a centuries-old church.



Day 5 Monday, 9 May - Onboard the MSC Sinfonia

A relaxing day onboard the MSC Sinfonia where a wealth of elegant entertainment areas as well as fitness and relaxation options are available. We will be able to explore and enjoy everything the MSC Sinfonia has to offer.

Day 6 Tuesday, 10 May - Mykonos

We will dock at 09:00 in Mykonos, which part of the Cyclades Island group in the Aegean Sea. The island is one of the most popular and glamorous Greek isles and is known for its nonstop party atmosphere. Beaches such as Paradise and Super Paradise welcomes a diverse crowd, with Sandside bars available along the beautiful stretch of white beaches to be explored and enjoyed into the early morning hours. **Embarkment at 02:00.**



Day 7 Wednesday, 11th May - Santorini

Docking at 07:00.

Santorini is one of the Cyclades islands in the Aegean Sea. It was devastated by

a volcanic eruption in the 16th century BC, forever shaping its rugged landscape. The whitewashed, cu-biform houses of its 2 principal towns, Fiera and Onia, cling to cliffs above an underwater caldera (crater). These towns overlook the sea and have small islands to the west that has beaches made up of black, red and white lava pebbles. Embarkment at 14:00.



Day 8 Thursday 12th May - Sarande, Albania

Docking at noon - 14h00.

Sarande is a charming ancient city set against the Albania Riviera. Make sure to travel up to the old Castle of Lekures where you will have spectacular surrounding view of the mountains, Butrint Lagoon, the island of Corfu on the beautiful Ionian Sea and Sarande Bay below. Embarkment at 20h00.



Day 9 Friday 13th May - Bari, Italy

Docking at 07h00.

Bari seems almost like two separate towns, with its picturesque old quarter and historic attractions crowded into a maze of narrow streets at the end of a peninsula. Then you get the spacious new town of broad avenues stretching to its south. The busy Corso Vittorio Emanuele II, a well-known shopping street, separates the new town from the old. Embarkment at 13h00.



Day 10 Saturday 14th May - Venice - Salzburg

The MSC Sinfonia will dock for a final time at 09:30 in Venice.

We continue our journey by luxury bus as we travel to Salzburg, Austria. The town is home to the well-known musical "The Sound of Music" and birthplace of the composer Mozart. The Old Town (Altstadt) is known internationally for his Baroque styles architecture and is one of the best-kept historical Middle Towns north of the Alps. This is UNESCO world heritage area. With three universities Salzburg has a busy student life. We walk to the cathedral where Mozart was baptized, see Mozart's birthplace and visit the Mirabel Palace and gardens. We will also walk through the popular shopping street, Getreidegasse. Dinner and overnight in Salzburg.



Day 11 Sunday 15th May - Passion Play Oberammergau, Germany

After breakfast we will travel to Oberammergau. Upon arrival we will settle in at our respective guest houses, thereafter we will have time to explore the village. The village is filled with numerous woodcarving and other boutique shops. Transport is freely available so you can come and go as you please. This afternoon we will be treated with an unforgettable experience as we attend the passion play concert.



Additional information: The concert will start after lunch at 14:00 and continue until 22:00. There will be a break for a delicious dinner that is included.

Overnight in Oberammergau surroundings.



Day 12 Monday, 16th May - Munich, Germany

After breakfast we travel to Neuschwanstein-Castle with his snow-white limestone façade and fairy tale-towers that stretches out above the treetops of the surrounding Hohenschwangau Valley. This castle of King Ludwig II is leaving so much for the imagination that it could easily be taken from the pages of a fairy-tale. Only 14 rooms of the planned 360rooms were completed before the death of Ludwig II in 1886. The visit to the inside of the castle is included.



We travel further to Munich, the capital of the state Bavaria. Dinner and overnight Munich. Tonight, a visit to the famous Hofbräuhaus is a possibility.



Day 13 Tuesday, 17th May - Munich - Johannesburg

This morning we will stop for a special visit to the **Marienplatz** on our way to the airport. Marienplatz is the heart of the city of Munich. Since 1158, this has been the city's main square. It's a must visit when you arrive in Munich. The square has a column called the **Marian column**, which was built in 1638 to celebrate the end of the Swedish occupation and for having being spared from the Thirty Years War. The column is topped by a gold statue of Virgin Mary and hence the name - Mary's Square.

There are 2 town halls in Old Munich - Old Town Hall and New Town Hall. **The Old Town Hall**, which was built in the 15th century in Gothic style, was completely destroyed in the 2nd World War and was later restored. It's now home to a toy museum. **The New Town Hall** is located by the Mary's Column. A huge Gothic style building, the new town hall, is home to the **Rathaus-Glockenspiel** of Munich. This is a miniature knight show, where every day at 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. the glockenspiel or the watchtower chimes and re-enacts two stories from the 16th century. This show lasts for 12 - 15 minutes. After our brief visit to the city square we are transferred to the Munich International Airport for our afternoon flight back to South Africa. Dinner on board.

Day 14 Wednesday, 18th May - Johannesburg

We arrive back home in Johannesburg in the morning, where we will meet our loved ones and have an abundance of stories, experiences and photos to share.






Inside cabin

CONDITIONS TO ALL PARTICIPANTS
